## **Begin Using Medical Marijuana**

With your medical marijuana card, you can legally purchase and use medical marijuana from licensed dispensaries in Oklahoma.

The state application fee is \$100 (plus a \$4.30 credit card processing fee) or the reduced fee of \$20 (plus a \$2.50 credit card processing fee) if eligible, and is non-refundable. The OMMA processes applications within 14 business days of receiving both the application and payment. Medical marijuana cards are valid for two years from the date of issuance, and annual certification renewal is required. If you need assistance at any point, don't hesitate to reach out to us.
