### **Visit the Vermont Marijuana Registry Website**

Go to the Vermont Cannabis Control Board website to begin your application process.



### **Create an Account**

Create an account on the website. You'll need a valid email address for this step.



### **Complete Application Form**

Fill out the application form with accurate personal information. Make sure to double-check for any errors before proceeding.



### **Upload Required Documents**

Prepare digital copies of your proof of Vermont residency and a valid form of identification (e.g., driver's license). Upload these documents securely to the website.



### **Obtain Physician Certification**

Obtain a certification from a licensed physician stating your eligibility for medical marijuana use. Make sure the certification is dated within the last six months.



### **Submit Application**

Once all required fields are filled, submit your application along with the non-refundable \$50 fee.



### **Application Review**

The Vermont Cannabis Control Board will review your application. This process may take some time, so be patient.



### **Approval Notification**

Upon approval, you will receive a notification via email or mail confirming your registration.

## Receive Registry Identification Card

Once approved, you will receive your registry identification card in the mail. This card serves as your official medical marijuana card in Vermont.

The state application fee is \$50 and non-refundable. The Vermont Cannabis Control Board processes applications and issues a registry identification card after reviewing and approving the application and payment. Medical marijuana cards are valid for one year from the date of issuance, and annual certification renewal is required. If you need assistance at any point, don't hesitate to reach out to us.
