Access Account

Log in to your existing account on the Vermont Cannabis Control Board website.

Review Personal Information

Check that all your personal information on file is accurate and up-to-date.

Upload Renewal Documents

If any of your residency or identification documents have expired, upload updated copies to the website.

Update Physician Certification

Obtain a new certification from your physician stating your continued eligibility for medical marijuana use. Ensure the certification is dated within the last six months.

Submit Renewal Application

Complete the renewal application form, making sure to indicate that you are renewing your registration.

Pay Renewal Fee

Submit the non-refundable renewal fee of \$50 along with your application.

Application Review

Your renewal application will be reviewed by the Vermont Cannabis Control Board. This process may take some time.

Approval Notification

Once approved, you'll receive a notification via email or mail regarding the renewal of your registration.

Receive Updated Registry Identification Card

Expect to receive your updated registry identification card in the mail.

Remember, the state application fee is \$50 and non-refundable. The Vermont Cannabis Control Board processes applications and issues a registry identification card after reviewing and approving the application and payment. Medical marijuana cards are valid for one year from the date of issuance, and annual certification renewal is required.
