### Obtain Provider Certification

Meet with a qualified healthcare provider to discuss your condition. If deemed appropriate, the provider will certify you for medical cannabis use.

#### **Receive Certification Email**

After certification, you will receive an email from the state cannabis system. This email will contain a link to proceed with your registration.

#### Follow the Link

Click the link in the email to start the registration process.

#### **Enter Personal Details**

Begin the registration process by entering your personal details as prompted.

About halfway through the process, you will be prompted to upload a clear picture of your state ID or passport.

## **Prove Hardship (If Applicable)**

If you're applying for a reduced fee due to financial hardship, upload the required proof of hardship at the designated step.

## **Pay Registration Fee**

No state fee is required. As of July 1, 2023, Minnesota eliminated the state registration fee, so you will not need to pay \$200 or \$50.

## **Await Confirmation**

The state will review your application and you will be notified of the outcome via email. Approval typically occurs within 30 days.

The state application fee is \$200/\$50 hardship and is non-refundable. The Department processes applications within 30 business days of receiving both the application and payment. Medical marijuana cards are valid for one year from the date of issuance, and annual certification renewal is required. If you need assistance at any point, don't hesitate to reach out to us.
